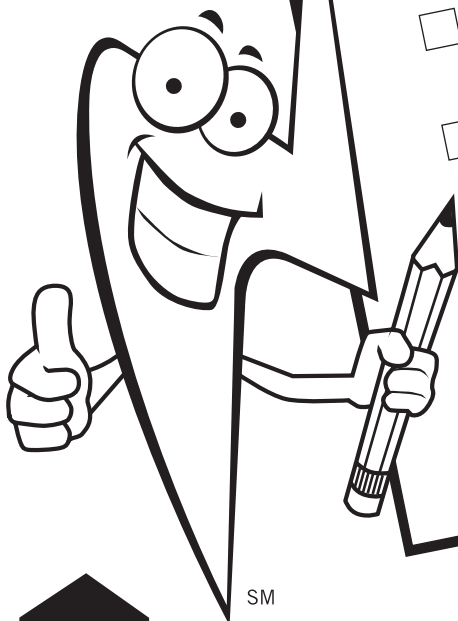


Bolty wants you to be safe.

Read these safety tips with your family
and check them off as you go.



- Don't fly kites or climb trees near power lines.
- Keep wet things like wading pools and water toys away from electric appliances and cords.
- Tell your parents to keep ladders away from power lines.
- Never poke your fingers or other things into electrical outlets.
- Don't overload outlets with too many plugs.
- Never touch a downed power line or go near a substation.
- Don't use hair dryers, curling irons, radios or anything electric around water.
- Be sure to dry off thoroughly after a bath or washing your hands before you touch anything electric.
- Never pull a plug out by its cord.
- "DANGER" means stay away! If you see a danger sign around electrical equipment, stay away.
- Sometimes the power goes out. You can be ready by creating an emergency kit with flashlights, extra batteries, first aid supplies and medications, a battery-powered radio or tv, water, food that does not need to be cooked or refrigerated, and other supplies.
