

# Sylvan Solar



AES' Sylvan project is a planned solar project under construction in Newaygo County, Michigan. We are committed to responsible clean energy development that creates long-term value and positive impact for both the environment and local communities.

The planned Sylvan solar project is located in south-central Newaygo County, MI. It will incorporate the most advanced solar energy technologies to support Michigan's goal of 100% carbon neutrality by 2050. AES will own and operate the Sylvan solar facility, which is anticipated to be under construction in 2027 and operational in early 2029.

## Project Overview:

- 220 MW solar
- Enough renewable energy to power nearly 55,183 Michigan homes annually
- 1,700 jobs expected to be created during peak construction, and an estimated 10 long-term operations and maintenance jobs
- 25+ million dollars expected to be generated for Newaygo County during the life of the project to support local schools, infrastructure and services.
