DMM Matter Number 21-00752 - Application of Riverside Solar, LLC for a Major Renewable Energy Facility Permit Pursuant to §94-c of the New York Executive Law to Construct a 100 Megawatt (MW) Solar Facility, in the Towns of Lyme and Brownville, Jefferson County.

NOTICE OF APPLICATION FILING AND
AVAILABILITY OF LOCAL AGENCY ACCOUNT FUNDING

(Issued October 18, 2021)

On October 18, 2021, Riverside Solar, LLC filed an application seeking a siting permit to develop, design, construct, operate, and decommission the Riverside Solar Facility with a nameplate generating capacity of up to 100 megawatts (MW), in the Towns of Lyme and Brownville, Jefferson County. The Facility will include but is not limited to, solar panels, access roads, substation, inverters, transformers, electrical collection lines, gen-tie line, battery storage, and temporary construction staging and storage areas. The Facility will interconnect at National Grid's Lyme Tap off of the Thousand Island - Coffeen 115kv line.

With its application, Riverside Solar, LLC submitted the required local agency account fee of \$100,000. Please take notice that funds are available to eligible local agencies and potential community intervenors for use in contributing to the development of a complete record leading to an informed decision by the Office of Renewable Energy Siting (ORES) as to its compliance with applicable local laws and regulations.

Local agencies and potential community intervenors intending to request local agency account funding must submit their request for funding by no later than **4:30 p.m. EST on November 17, 2021**. Parties requesting such funding must use the **ORES Request For Local Agency Account Funding** form available in the Resources section of the ORES website (www.ores.ny.gov/resources).

All parties requesting funding must register as a party on the Department of Public Service's Document Matter and Management (DMM) system,¹ consent to electronic service, and file the funding request form electronically (EFile). ¹ All persons who register as a party are provisionally added to the party list. Formal party status is conferred upon ruling of the Administrative Law Judges.

In addition to Efiling, all requests for local agency account funding must also be submitted by email to ORES (general@ores.ny.gov) and served on Administrative Law Judge Richard A. Sherman (richard.sherman@dec.ny.gov) and Administrative Law Judge Anthony Belsito (anthony.belsito@dps.ny.gov).

The requests must be received by **November 17, 2021**.
