**Chateaugay Wind Update**

AES continues to advance development of the Chateaugay Wind Repowering Project in the Town of Chateaugay. The project is an existing wind facility proposed for repowering to extend its useful life and increase generating capacity. Project development and permitting activities are ongoing, and AES continues to coordinate with agencies, consultants, and local stakeholders in the Town of Chateaugay, Franklin County as the project moves through the Article VIII process.

Chateaugay Wind issued its 60-day notice of intent to file an Article VIII permit application in January 2025. The project filed its Article VIII permit application with the Office of Renewable Energy Siting and Electric Transmission (ORES) on June 30, 2025, and received a notice of incomplete application on August 29<sup>th</sup>, 2025. and received its notice of complete application on January 29, 2026. ORES staff published draft permit conditions on March 10, 2026, and a public comment hearing took place on May 12, 2026. AES is waiting for the final sitting permit and will continue to provide updates as the permitting process progresses.
